#### Introduction

This document describes the data package "Queensland Annual Mineral Production and Sales Statistics from 1877 to 2020-21", which was produced to provide the Queensland annual mineral production and value statistics from 1989-90 through to 2020-21.

The document describes the data sources used to collate data from 1989-90 to 2020-21, which is published on a whole of Queensland basis.

It also provides instructions for accessing data published before 1989-90, some of which includes regional data.

### Collation of the data

The annual publication of the Queensland mineral production and sales statistics is the responsibility of the Queensland Department of Resources. Over the past years, this department has been merged with other departments, resulting in changes to where this data was published. From 1990 through to 2005, the annual production and value statistics were published in several publications.

With the development of the department's websites, data from 2004-05 through to 2014-15 was no longer available for public access as time progressed. This data is included in this report.

For data from 1877 through to 1989, the annual statistics were published in the Queensland Department of Mines Annual Reports. These reports can all be accessed via the <u>GSQ Open Data Portal</u> (portal). Instructions for accessing Queensland Department of Mines Annual Reports via the portal can be found at the bottom of this report. Up until 1982, these statistics were provided based on calendar year; after this date, data has been provided on a financial year (1 July to 30 June) basis.

A full table of years and data sources from 1989-90 to 2020-21 is provided at the bottom of this report (Table 1). The Queensland Minerals and Energy Review, which was later called Queensland Minerals and Petroleum Review, is not published in the portal. These data were extracted and scanned from hard copies held by the Queensland Department of Environment and Science. Data for the years 2013-14 and 2014-15 were sourced from the Queensland's Metalliferous and Industrial Minerals publication, also not available on the portal.

An additional spreadsheet provided is the preliminary 2014-15 annual statistics. The published statistics for 2014-15 do not breakdown the gemstones into types. The only reference recovered was the preliminary data sheet, which is to be referred to only if wanting data on gemstones.

# **Instructions for accessing Queensland Department of Mines annual mineral statistics**

The following instructions are for using the GSQ Open Data portal to access mineral production statistics published between 1877 and 1988-89.

- 1. Access the GSQ Open Data Portal GSQ | GSQ (data.qld.gov.au).
- 2. Click the report type you wish to search being "Report" (Figure 1).

Figure 1: The type of data required is "Report".



3. Search on "Title" and enter "Annual Report Queensland Department of Mines" (Figures 2 and 3).

Figure 2: To search on "Title" select from dropdown of attributes.



Figure 3: Under "Title" write "Annual Report Queensland Department of Mines".



This will bring up a listing of all the Queensland Department of Mines annual reports. To search for annual reports after 1988-89, remove the "Mines" from the search.
